My **hybrid profile** integrates a design sensibility with the technical solidity gained through on-site experience, ensuring coherence between idea and execution throughout the entire process. During the **Master in Material Research at Elisava** (Barcelona, 2024) I developed tools to analyse future scenarios, identify emerging trends and translate research into design decisions — a strategic perspective I bring to each project as added research value.
